HOW TO PRINT IN CELLICA DATABASE APPLICATION? (Personal/Enterprise Edition)

Cellica Database (Wi-Fi, Internet and Anywhere) Personal Edition or Enterprise Edition

Details:

You can Print form with record in Cellica Database application on device side. You need to setup "Print" button on form to print the form. Follow the steps given below to use print feature in Cellica Database on your iOS or Android device.

Cellica Database Form Designer:

Put Button control on Form and set Action property to "Print". You can set different properties like "Page Size", "Page Range" and "FitToPage".

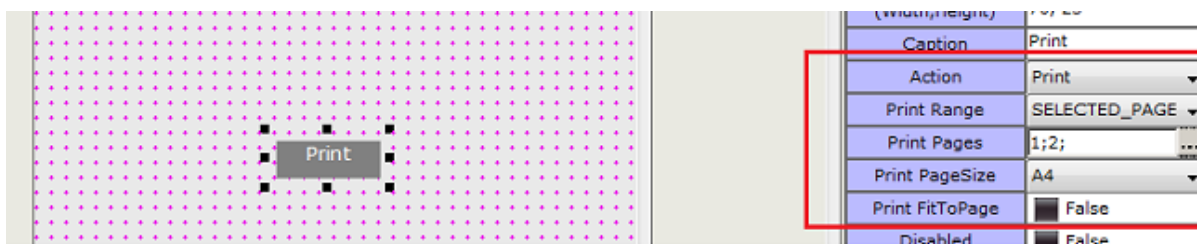


Figure 1: Setting up "Print" button while designing form

"Page Size": can be set to "LETTER", "LEGAL" or "A4"

"Page Range" : Can be set to ,

"CURRENT PAGE" – Prints only current tab of form

"SELECTED PAGE": You can specify the tab numbers of form you want to print while design time. Like if you have 4 tabs on form and you wish to print only tab no 1 and 3.

"ALL PAGES": It will print all tabs on form.

"FitToPage": It will stretch the form image to cover total page size.

Device Side Cellica Database Application:

iOS:
 You can either directly print to Air Print Enabled printer from Cellica Database application or email the pdf containing your print information which you can print later on any printer connected to desktop computer.

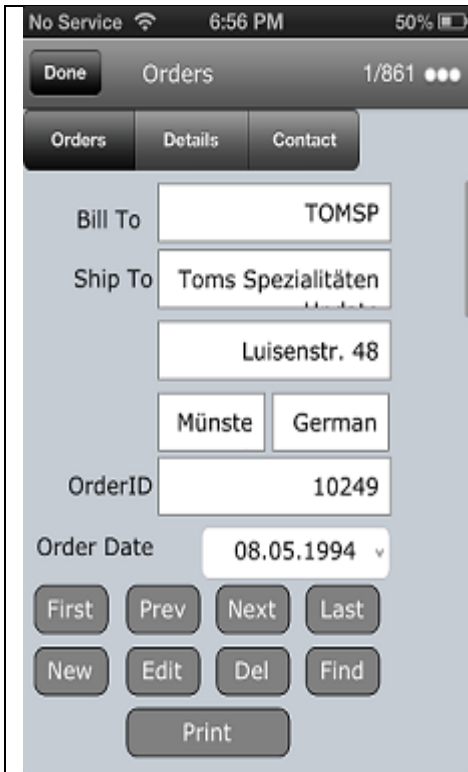


Figure 2: "Print" button on form

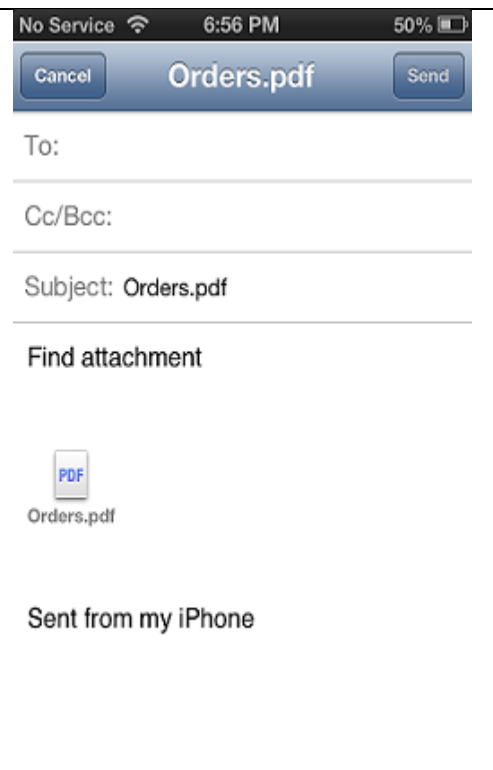


Figure 5: Email Print job to mail

Android:

You can print directly from your android device using “Google Cloud Print”. In addition to it also you can either store Print job as a pdf file on android local store and can use free application like “**PrinterShare™ Mobile Print**” to print this later from your android device or email the pdf containing your print job which you can print later on any printer connected to desktop computer.

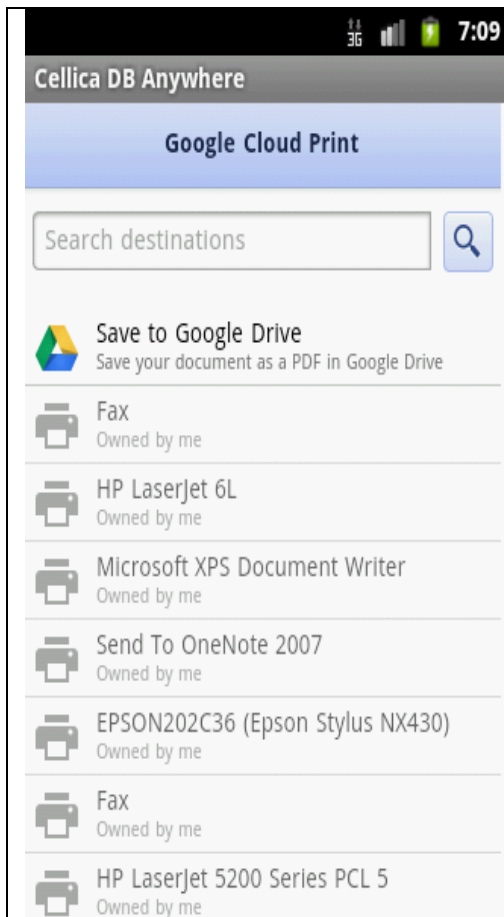


Figure 8: Print using Google Cloud print

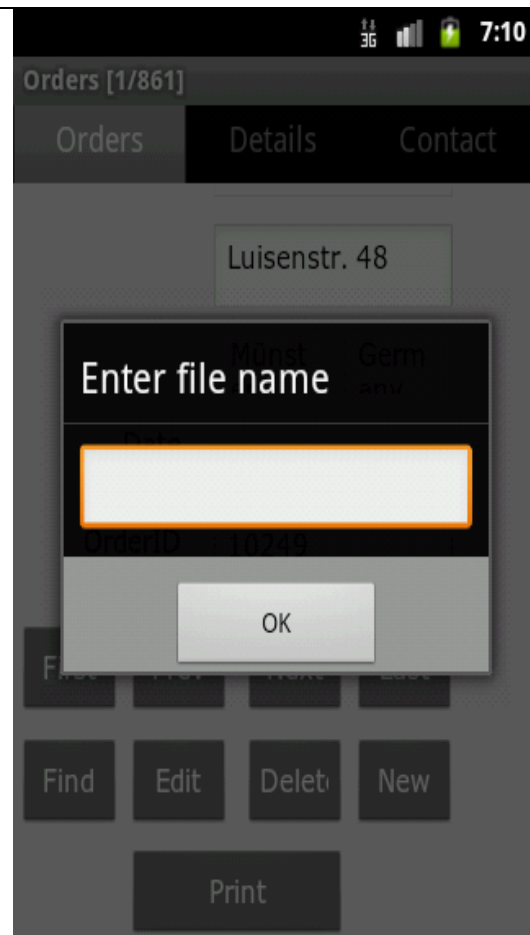


Figure 9: Save Print job as PDF file on device

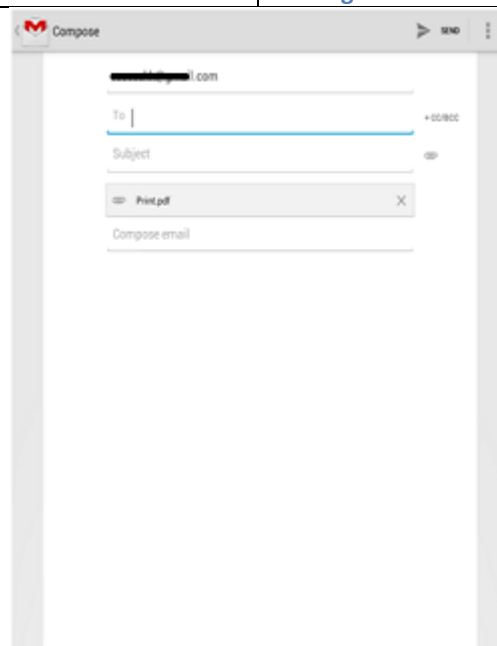


Figure 10: Email Print job as a PDF file
